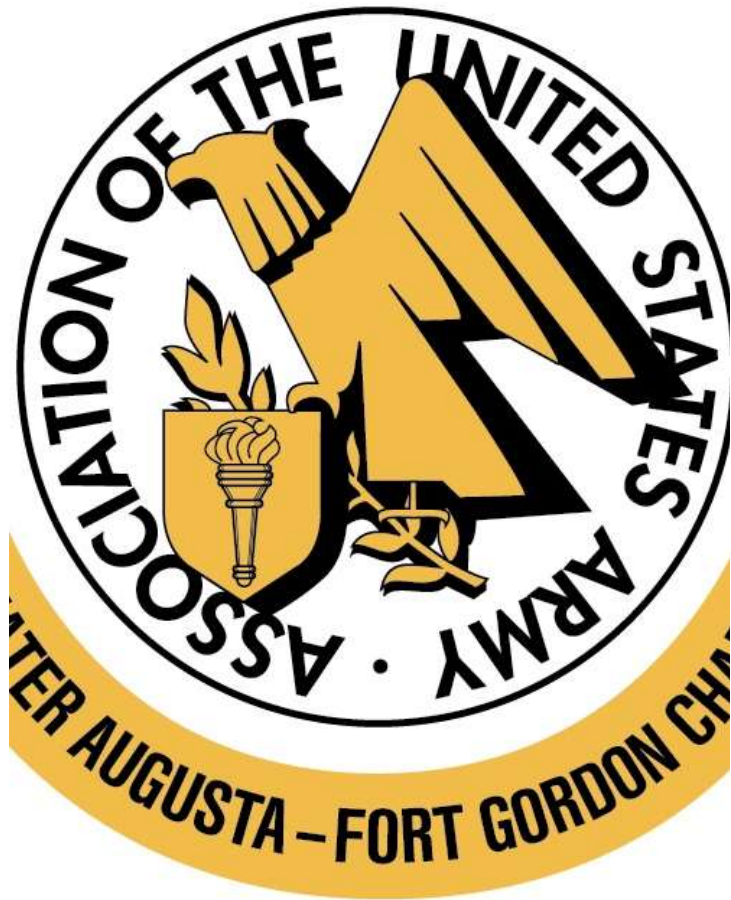

Alliance for Fort Gordon - History

The Alliance was created in March 2003 by Congressman Charlie Norwood as a non-profit organization with the primary mission to create awareness in the community of the threat of base closure and the potential economic impact should Ft Gordon be downsized or closed.

In November 2005, the 2005 Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) Commission Report became law and Fort Gordon was officially spared any negative impact from this latest round of base realignment and closure. The primary reason Fort Gordon survived was its military value - the ability to efficiently and effectively perform its assigned missions and its potential to support new missions. Other major contributing factors, however, were the strong community support for our servicemembers and their families and the outstanding quality of life enjoyed by area residents.

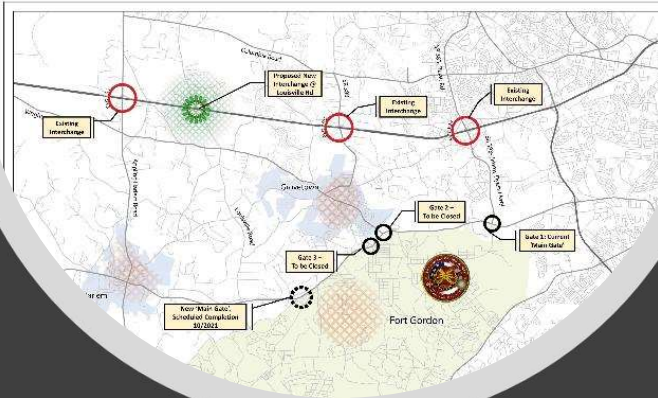

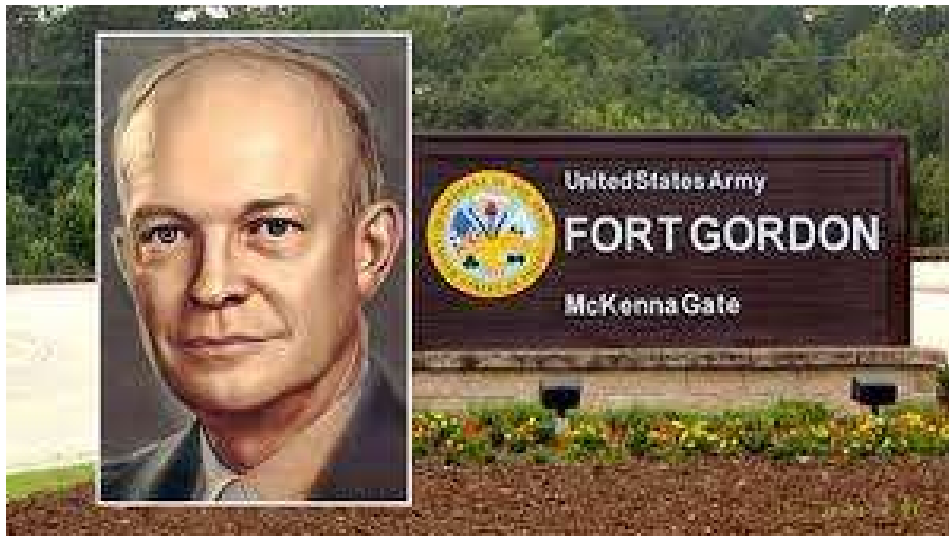

Renaming Commission - timeline

1. By Oct. 1, 2022, the commission must submit a report detailing its suggestions to the House and Senate Armed Services Committees.
2. After that, the Pentagon will have until early 2024 to rename the items based on the commission's plan.
3. President Joe Biden has said he supports the renaming of the military bases, and the NDAA set aside \$2 million for the effort.
4. It's possible Biden could accelerate the timeline with congressional or military support.

Cyber Talent Initiatives (working)

The Georgia Cyber Center (GCC) completed the co-development of the Department of Labor (DoL) grant for H1B One Workforce Training, which was led by the Augusta Economic Development Association (AEDA) and assisted by the CSRA Alliance for Fort Gordon and ICF Consulting. The grant was submitted on 12 NOV, with award results expected in the first quarter of 2021. The \$10M grant is focused on training and placing veterans in local cybersecurity jobs.

***** UPDATE: The Augusta Economic Development Authority (the AEDA) received a nearly \$9 million award from the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL) H-1B One Workforce Grant Program. The Alliance for Fort Gordon is a partner and is responsible for the outreach committee/efforts. This grant will greatly benefit military veterans and military spouses across our entire region.

SFL-TAP On-line Posting of Career Announcements Requirements Paper

- The target audience for all on-line posting of career announcements are to Transitioning Soldiers, their Spouses, and Veterans
- The posting of career announcements to the SFL-TAP website are FREE of charge to employers that meet the following criteria:

The following MUST BE MET to have your career announcement(s) posted to the SFL-TAP website

- The career announcement must be sent as an attachment (one page) pdf file
- The career announcement must be a current and open position with the company submitting the announcement and the company whom the career is with has to be listed on the announcement
- The career announcement must state the title and location for the particular career
- The career announcement must have the steps and links of how to apply for the position in the actual announcement. The link needs to be to the actual career on the company's website OF to the company's career site where the career title can be searched from key words OF a point of contact person must be listed with an email address listed in the actual announcement so Soldiers, their Spouses, and Veterans can send their resume' and additional questions to a point of contact for the particular opening. The point of contact person listed must be an employee of the company with the announcement
- Closing date:
 - Employers are required to notify SFL-TAP when the position is filled by a veteran that was connected through this office.
 - If the position does not have a closing date we will automatically remove the announcement from our site 30 days from the request to post date

Note: SFL-TAP will not post career announcements for any 3rd party recruiting or to a generic website to search for careers

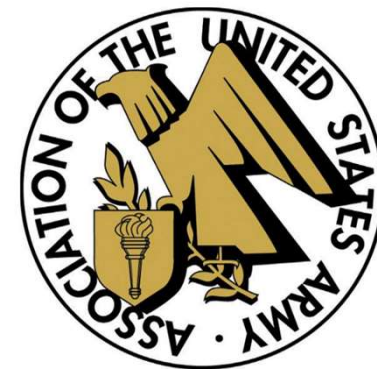
